- 2. Entry Form must be signed by a parent or legal guardian. As this is a youth tournament with multiple ages only signed copies from a parent or legal guardian will be accepted.
- 3. Entry forms can be completed for up to 3 family members.
- 4. By signing the form, you acknowledge that BCTF is not responsible for any costs associated with travel or lodging to participate in the CTF Canadian Youth Championships.
- 5. As per CTF policy each bowler must stay in the host hotel with a parent or guardian while at the CTF Canadian Youth Championships regardless of age.
- 6. Tournament officials, coaches both local and Provincial team and Team Managers are all volunteers. Any behavior that is a deterrent to the bowler, team, coaches or manager will not be tolerated. Behavior that is a deterrent to the team will lead to a review of the team members participation in the tournament.
- 7. No Refunds once entry fee is received. Refunds may be considered on an individual basis due to extenuating circumstances at the discretion of the BC Tenpin Federation board of directors.
